

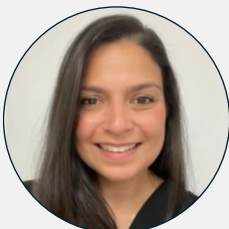

Emergency Medicine Specialist & Co-Director of Emergency Medicine Training

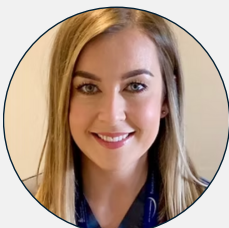
